

Code of Conduct for Students

As a student taking part in Luna Acrobatics and Aerial Arts classes and events, we expect you to:

Practicalities

- arrive to sessions on time, if you are late please ask the coach if you are still okay to join the session
- make sure you have the right and appropriate kit for the session as well as enough food and drink
- tie hair back away from the face and remove all jewellery
- complete all consent, contact and medical forms and update us straight away if anything changes
- please respect that Luna is a space that is free from drugs, alcohol, tobacco, vapes and swearing please do not drink, smoke or vape inside our venues at any show or training session
- do not to come to classes, training or a show when you are sick, contagious or have an injury that inhibits your training. You should not train if you are unable to do so
- for students under the age of 18, please do not leave the venue without a parent/ carer
- avoid using your phone in classes, unless taking a photograph of yourself. Please ask
 permission of the coach and other students before doing this and do not photograph anyone else
 without their consent
- do not bring valuable items with you where possible, these should be left at home. Luna cannot be responsible for the loss or damage of such items

Behaviour

- listen to coaches and follow instructions at all times, do not teach each other moves
- maintain good standards of behaviour at all times
- think about how the way you and your guests react and behave whilst at Luna, events or competitions where you are acknowledged as a Luna student
- unless booked onto the class, do not enter the training space when lessons are on unless asked by the coaches
- be polite and considerate to others, be patient and wait your turn sensibly
- please do not walk on the mats and training space in wet or dirty shoes, leave litter at Luna venues – although we are mainly in the air, we like our spaces to be clean!
- students should pay attention to their personal hygiene, ensuring both they and their clothes are clean. The use of deodorant is encouraged
- use social media responsibly when talking about what goes on at our club, by behaving in the same way online as you would in person
- please do not be offended but coaches and volunteers will not be able to accept friend/ follow requests from any student under the age of 18. Coaches will not add you as friends or follow you, nor message you directly
- students over the age of 18, please do not be offended if a coach does not accept a friend/ follow request, they may want to keep their personal and Luna lives separate
- bulling and harassment will not be tolerated
- respect the rights, dignity and values of others
- do not encourage or pressure others into acting against the code
- talk to us if you have any concerns about any part of your involvement we want to hear from you



Persistent concerns or breaches may result in the person(s) being asked not to attend shows, events and training sessions if their attendance is considered a risk to the welfare and enjoyment of participants.

Continued issues and repeated breaches of this code may result in us regrettably asking you to leave Luna Acrobatics and Aerial Arts permanently, which is something we never want to do.
